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COURSE OVERVIEW

This unit describes a participant's skills and knowledge required to enter and work in confined spaces in the Resources and Infrastructure Industries.

This unit is appropriate for those working in operational roles undertaking work in confined spaces.

COURSE ELEMENTS

• Planning and preparing for work in confined space by applying procedures and safety requirements to ensure the activity is compliant, confirming regulatory requirements & the emergency response procedure, implementing signage/barriers, selecting appropriate equipment, applying environmental protection requirements & correctly positioning rescue equipment... • Working in a confined space by gaining access to/entering a confined space, testing and monitoring the atmosphere, correctly tagging & following lock-out procedures, maintaining communication, complying with permit requirements & adhering to allocated entry time. • Exiting a confined space by conducting appropriate inspections, removing tagging & lock-out & accurately completing your entry permit.
