CONDITIONS OF LICENCE

Controlled Substances (Pesticides) Regulations, 2003

CSR/PE/4.1

Pest Controller's Licence

- The holder of the licence will maintain any premises and equipment used for the purposes of the holder's pest control business in a clean, efficient and safe working condition;
- The holder of the licence will ensure that any pesticide, while handled or used in the course of the holder's pest control business, is under the direct control of the holder of a pest management technician's licence;
- The holder of the licence will ensure that any unused pesticide or any container used to hold a pesticide in the course of the pest controller's business is disposed of in a manner not likely to endanger the health of any person;
- The holder of the licence must ensure that the holder of a Limited Pest Management Technicians licence is supervised in accordance with Regulation 4 of the Controlled Substances (Pesticides) Regulations 2003;
- The holder of the licence, where authorised to conduct vertebrate pest control, must ensure that 1080 baits used for vertebrate pest control be obtained only from the South Australian Natural Resources Management Board responsible for the area being baited;
- Such other conditions as the Licensing Authority thinks fit to impose and specifies in the licence or by notice in writing given personally or by post to the holder of the licence;
- Unless individually endorsed, in accordance with Regulation 25(6) of the Controlled Substances (Poisons) Regulations 2011, an endorsement for 'Fumigants' excludes cyanogen, chloropicrin unless its possession in pure form does not exceed 7 litres or 5% in compound preparations and excludes methyl bromide unless its use is for quarantine pre-shipment (QPS) purposes or for non-QPS purposes that have been approved under critical use exemptions as determined by the Commonwealth Department of Sustainability, Environment, Water, Population and Communities; and
- Unless individually endorsed, in accordance with Regulation 25(6) of the Controlled Substances (Poisons) Regulations 2011, an endorsement for 'Rodenticides' excludes strychnine unless in possession of less than 5 kilograms of baits designed for destroying mice and does not exceed 0.5% of strychnine.
