COURSE OVERVIEW



This unit of competency covers the functions required to prepare and operate a forklift to meet minimum training and assessment standards for the purposes of certification. If eligible, you may be entitled to have this course partially subsidised under CSQ Funding. Upon successful completion of any of these courses you will receive a Statement of Attainment; and upon application to Workplace Health & Safety a High Risk Work Licence.

*Equivalent Mining Competencies for these units are also available

COURSE ELEMENTS

- Planning the work by identifying any potential hazards, implementing risk control measures, selecting the appropriate forklift truck, inspecting the working area and establishing effective communication methods.
- Conducting routine checks pre-start and post-start by review of signage, labels and safety functions and reporting any issues, defects or damage identified.
- Shifting the load
- Shutting down and securing the forklift truck in addition to conducting routine post-operational checks.

COURSE FRAMEWORK

FORMAL TRAINING

Duration: 1 - 2 days

Training can be completed at workplace or on-site at SDS Training.

ASSESSMENT

Assessment is conducted by one of our accredited WH&SQ assessors upon confirmation by student and trainer that they are ready for assessment.
