## CERTIFICATE III IN RURAL OPERATIONS

### COURSE OVERVIEW



This qualification provides an occupational outcome in agriculture, horticulture and conservation land management and at least one and up to four other related industries. Depending on the units selected individuals will be able to seek employment not only in rural industries but also other industry sectors, such as local government, tourism, hospitality, transport, construction, information technology and metals.

On successful completion of this course, students will receive a full Certificate of Qualification: AHC32816 Certificate III in Rural Operations.

### COURSE FUNDING OPTIONS

### CERTIFICATE 3 GUARANTEE ELIGIBILITY

- Are an Australian or New Zealand citizen, Australian permanent resident (including humanitarian entrants) or temporary resident who meet the visa requirements and who are on the pathway to permanent residency).
- Are a Queensland resident aged 15 years or over.
- Are no longer at school (except VETiS students)
- Have not completed and/or are not enrolled in a Certificate III level or higher qualification (qualifications completed at school and foundation skills training are exemptions)
