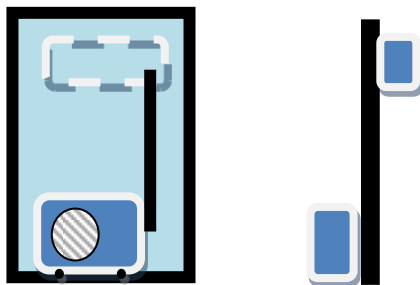

What is a Standard, Back to Back Installation?

- The indoor unit is installed on or against an external wall
- The outdoor unit is installed on an existing flat and level surface
- Maximum refrigerant pipe length between the Indoor unit and outdoor unit is 3 meters
- Maximum drain length of 5m
- Maximum power circuit length of 20m



What is not included in a standard installation?

- Delivery of the Air Conditioner
- Any additional parts or extra costs
- Decommissioning or removal of an old unit
- Switchboard or mains power upgrades

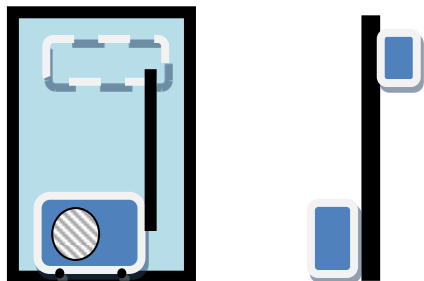
