

COURSE OVERVIEW



This course reflects the role of workers in the community and/or residential setting who follow an individualised plan to provide person-centered support to people who may require support due to ageing, disability or a variety of additional reasons.

On successful completion of this course, students will receive a full Certificate of Qualification: CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support. To achieve this qualification, students must complete at least 120 hours of work placement as detailed in the Assessment Requirements of the units of competency.
